## Did You Know – The Blessed Youth of the Holy Prophet

*(May Allah Send Peace And Blessings Upon Him)*

Q: How the kuffaar of Makkah Mukarramah used to call him?

A: By the titles of “Saadiq” (Truthful) and “Ameen” (Trustworthy).

Q: What was his occupation in his youth?

A: To trade.

Q: Where did he travel to for business?

A: To Shaam (Syria).

Q: Which wealthy woman of Makkah Mukarramah gave him the proposal of business with her?

A: Hazrat Khadeejah – may Allah be pleased with her.

Q: How many times did he travel to foreign lands prior to proclaiming his Prophethood?

A: Twice.

Q: In which battle did he partake for the first time?

A: Harb Fujjaar.

Q: What was his age at that time?

A: 15 years.

Q: Did he fight in that battle?

A: No.

Q: How long did the battle last?

A: 10-15 days.

Q: What was the treaty that took place in his youth?

A: Half Al-Fadool.

Q: What was its objective?

A: To keep the peace.

Q: Why was the treaty named Half Al-Fadool?

A: Because most of the members that partook in it their first names were Fadl.

Q: When the Quraish started the construction of the Holy Ka'bah, what was his age at that time?

A: 35 years.

Q: What was the reason for the fight that occurred between the leaders of Quraish at the time of construction?

A: On placing the Hajar Aswad.

Q: How long did it last?

A: 5 days.

Q: Who was the third party that resolved the conflict?

A: The Holy Prophet – may Allah send peace and blessings upon him.

Q: Who placed the Hajar Aswad with his own hands?

A: The holy Prophet – may Allah send peace and blessings upon him.

Q: How did he resolve the conflict between the parties?

A: He put the Hajar Aswad (Black Stone) in a sheet and told the leaders of all four major tribes to hold all four corners of the sheet, and this is how the conflict was resolved.

Q: On which day was Hajar Aswad placed?

A: On Monday.

Q: Why do people kiss it?

A: It is from paradise, and because the Holy Prophet – may Allah send peace and blessings upon him – kissed it therefore all the Muslims also kiss it.

Q: What are the names of people who were in search of truth prior to the proclamation of Prophethood?

A: Zaid Ibn ‘Amr, Warqah Ibn Naufal, ‘Ubaidah Ibn Habsh and ‘Uthmaan Ibn Haarith.

Q: Were there some people on true religion even prior to the proclamation of his Prophethood?

A: Yes, they were Warqah Ibn Naufal, Zaid Ibn ‘Amr, Abu Qais and some other individuals besides them as well.

Q: Why did Allah Almighty swear by the city of Makkah Mukarramah in Surah Al-Balad of the Holy Quran?

A: Because the Holy Prophet – may Allah send peace and blessings upon him – was born in that city and resided there.

Q: What are the names of the most significant friends of the Holy Prophet – may Allah send peace and blessings upon him – prior to the proclamation of his Prophethood?

A: They were four:

1. Hazrat Abu Bakr Siddeeq – may Allah be pleased with him
2. Hakeem Ibn Haraam
3. Damaad Ibn Tha’labah
4. Qais Ibn Saaib Makhzoomi

Q: What is the name of the mountain near Makkah Mukarramah where the Holy Prophet – may Allah send peace and blessings upon him – used to worship?

A: Jabal Noor.
