It is mentioned that there was a pious person among the Bani Israel who lived secluded from the rest of his nation. He lived alone in a mountain. Near him was a stream and through this, he was able to make Wudu and manage to survive in this barren place. He also planted a few trees and through this, he was able to acquire some food. During the day, he kept fast and during the night, he spent the entire night in Ibadah. His every moment and second was spent in serving the Almighty Allah. In fact, this was also clearly seen in his features.

When Nabi Moosa - *peace be upon him* - heard about this person, he decided to visit him. However, when Nabi Moosa - *peace be upon him* - saw that this person was busy in Dhikr and Ibadah, he decided not to disturb him and returned home.

During the night, he went to visit this person. This person was also making Ibadah at that time as well. Nabi Moosa - *peace be upon him* - then said to him, “It would be better for you if you are easy on yourself.”

The person replied, “O Prophet of Allah Almighty! I am in great fear that if I do not do this, perchance I might die while I am oblivious of the Dhikr of Allah Almighty. And if I die in this fashion, then I would be someone who ignored the remembrance of Allah Almighty.”
