Read your Missed Salaah

Do not display laziness in this regard. One does not have any idea when death will arrive. Bear in mind that as long as one had not fulfilled the Fard, the acts of Nawaafil will not be accepted. The easiest example of doing this is to mention this is a numerical fashion. In other words, when you are about to perform a Qada of Fajr, make the Niyyah that this is the Qada of the first Fajr you missed and so on and so forth. This is also applicable to all the other Salaah as well. The same will also be applicable to all the other Fard deeds as well such as fasting, Zakah, etc.

Also bear in mind that there is a very slight chance that you will ever complete this in your life time. However, the mere intention which you possess will see you in good light in the Hereafter. Islam has taught us that Allah Almighty does not see the outer side of a person but He looks at the intention of a person.

The act of also fulfilling the Haj which one had had also deliberately missed should also be completed as soon as possible. The Holy Prophet - *may Allah's peace and blessings be upon him* - has also made it clear that the person who deliberately omits performing the Hajj, then it is equal whether he dies as a Jew or a Christian. May Allah protect us from this. Ameen.
