Shaikh Ali Raoudbari - *may Allah be pleased with him* – narrates:

Once I placed a Derwish in the grave. I removed the cover from his head and placed his head on the ground. However, as I placed his head on the ground, he opened his eyes and declared, “O Abu Ali!
