Hadrat Sayyiduna Yusuf bin Husain - *may Allah be pleased with him* - narrates that he heard Hadrat Sayyiduna Zun Nun Misri - *may Allah be pleased with him* - relate, “I was once in the mountains in Syria and I saw a few people who were wearing woollen clothing. In one hand, they had a water container and in one hand they had a walking stick. When they saw me, they began to say to themselves, ‘Come, let us approach Abu Faiz, Zun Nun Misri.’
