Suddenly another person appeared from the same hole in whose hand there was a whip and he said to me, "O Abdullah! Never give this person water because he is a Kaafir."

After saying this, this person then whipped this person and through this whipping, he again fell into the hole. When I returned to Madina Shareef, I approached the Holy Prophet - may Allah's peace and blessings be upon him - and informed him about what I had seen. When he heard this, the Holy Prophet - may Allah's peace and blessings be

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upon him - mentioned, "You have seen him." And I replied, "Yes, I had seen him." He declared, "This was the enemy of Allah, Abu Jahl.
