Then a small piece of paper as little as the finger will be revealed on which will be recorded the witness-ship (of this person) on the Divine Oneness of Allah Almighty and the Prophethood of the Holy Prophet - *may Allah's peace and blessings be upon him*. When this piece of paper will be placed on the other side of the scale, then it will be much mightier than his bad deeds and Allah Almighty will pardon the person just for the sake of the Kalimah. He will then be told to enter Jannah. (Tafseer Tabari)

It is through the blessed being of the Holy Prophet - *may Allah's peace and blessings be upon him* - that all of these rewards and gifts have been given to the Ummah.
