Hadrat Sayyiduna Abdur Rahman bin Na'am Bijili - *may Allah be pleased with him* - was considered as among the eminent scholars and Saints of Kufah. He is also a student of Hadrat Sayyiduna Abu Hurayrah and Hadrat Sayyiduna Abu Saeed Khudri - *may Allah be pleased with him*. There were also many eminent Saints and scholars that were his students and Mureeds.

He was noted for his amazing miracles. In fact, such was the state of his Ibadah, that Imam Bukair bin Aamir - *may Allah be pleased with him* - admits that if this Saint was informed that the Angel of Death was about to appear to him, still too, he would not have been able to perform more Ibaadah than what he used to perform already. He also performed Hajj every year.

One of his amazing miracles took place when he was arrested by Hujjaj bin Yusuf and was placed in a dark room. He was locked in this dark room for fifteen days without food. The tyrant then ordered his guards to open the door so that they could remove the dead corpse of the Saint. However, when they opened the door of the cell, they found the great Saint peacefully performing his Salaah. When Hujjaj saw this, he was amazed and at the same time a deep sense of fear and awe also appeared in him. He then ordered that the Saint be released that he was free to go wherever he wanted.
