

When these words were presented to him by Hadrat Sa'ad - may Allah be pleased with him - he thought to himself, "How can my pretty and intelligent daughter actually marry someone of this quality."

Without thinking, he refuted the proposal of Hadrat Sayyiduna Sa'ad - may Allah be pleased with him. He severely reprimanded him and told him to go back. All the time, the daughter was listening to this conversation. As soon as Hadrat Sayyiduna Sa'ad - may Allah be pleased with him - turned around to leave, she immediately came to the door and called out, "O the servant of Allah! Please come back.
