In the faculty of Ahadith, he was also the among the teachers of such great scholars as Imam Shu'bah, Imam Sufyan Thouri, Imam Sufyan bin Ayniyah, Imam Abdullah ibn Mubaarak, Imam Hammad bin Salamah - *may Allah be pleased with them*. Imam ibn Mo'een, Imam Nisaa'i and
