

عَنُ مُجَاهِدٍ وَطُورِ قَالَ: جَبَلُ. سِينِينَ قَالَ: مُبَارَكُ بِالسُّهُ يَانِيَّةِ.

Sayyiduna Mujahid – may Allah be pleased with him – is reported to have said: Toor means mountain and Sinai or Seeneen means "blessed" in Syriac.

وَعَنْ عِكْمِ مَةَ قَالَ: الْجَبَلُ الَّذِي نَادَى اللهُ جَلَّ ثَنَاؤُكُمْ مِنْهُ مُوسَى عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامُ.

Sayyiduna 'Ikramah – may Allah be pleased with him – is reported to have said: It is the mountain from where Allah Almighty had a dialogue with Sayyiduna Moosa had – peace be upon him.
