{إِنَّ الْأَبْرَارَ لَفِي نَعِيمٍ } الْأَبْرَارُ الَّذِينَ بَرُّوا وَصَدَقُوا فِي إِيمَانِهِمْ بِأَدَاءِ فَرَائِضِ اللهِ عَزَّوَجَلَّ وَاجَلَّ وَاجَلَّ اللهِ عَزَّوَجَلَّ وَاجْتِنَابِ مَعَاصِيهِ.

Undoubtedly the righteous ones are in bliss i.e. those righteous who did good and were truthful in their faith by fulfilling Allah's duties and abstaining from disobedience.
